## Julius Rosenwald Fund.

 Archives, 1917-48.Scope note

The archives of the Julius Rosenwald Fund contain approximately 150,000 items, the bulk of which reflect activities of the Fund during the $1928-48$ period. Only occasionally letters or reports are dated before the major reorganization of the Fund in 1928. The Julius Rosenwald Fund was incorporated in Chicago on October 30, 1917, as a non-profit corporation having as its purpose the promotion of "the well-being of mankind."

Like a number of other foundations in their early years, the Fund from 1917 to 1928 remained largely under the personal control of the founder, Julius Rosenwald (1862-1932). Mr. Rosenwald became president of Sears, Roebuck and Co. in 1909. Almost immediately he initiated a program of personal beneficence. His contributions knew no restrictions of race, creed, or color. Rosenwald first met Booker T. Washington in 1911, and from that moment until 1948, Negro interests realized the foremost benefits of Rosenwald philanthropy. The personal papers of Julius Rosenwald, which include the archives of the Fund to 1928, were deposited in the library of the University of Chicago.

The first program undertaken by Rosenwald stemmed from his relationship with Washington at Tuskegee Institute. Rural schoolhouses for southern Negroes were constructed on a matching fund basis. This arrangement became formalized with the 1917 incorporation. When the building of schoolhouses became too extensive to be handled by Tuskegee Institute, a branch of the Fund's Chicago office was established in Nashville in 1920. During this entire first phase (1909-1928) Rosenwald's personal philanthropies and the work of the Fund, financed by Sears stock, remained indistinguishable.

A drastic reorganization of the Fund on January 1, 1928, effected the transition from private to corporate giving. Edwin Rogers Embree (1883-1950) became president of the Fund, employed a full-time staff in a Chicago headquarters, and responded to the directions of a newly created board of trustees. The papers of the corporate Fund, 1928-48, occupy 572 manuscripts boxes (ca. 248 linear feet) and include some 150,000 items. Included in this collection are correspondence, financial records and accounts, memoranda, agenda, minutes, reports, resolutions, biographical sketches, articles, studies, and publications of the Fund (some printed)-as well as photographs, clippings, and scrapbooks.

The documents of the reorganized Fund reflect the new directions taken by its officers and trustees. The program, originally concerned with building schoolhouses, began expanding until it finally included aid to colleges for teacher training and Negro leadership, fellowships for promising Negroes and whites, research on Negro health and medical services, book subsidies for

county and school libraries, appropriations for specific social studies, and contributions to agencies and individuals working in the field of race relations.

Julius Rosenwald had a firm belief that the generation which contributed to the making of wealth should be the one to benefit by it. He thus stipulated that the Fund expend its interest and principle within twentyfive years of the donor's death (1932). Edwin Embree closed the Fund in 1948.

## Correspondence

Letters in these archives provide the most interesting and largest segment of the collection. The correspondence is between officers of the Fund and organizations or individuals having some connection with the work of the Fund. Officers, staff, and trustees of the Fund included an array of prominent figures. In addition, these people communicated with other members of the same articulate leadership group. A few of the major correspondents include the following: Will W. Alexander, J. Curtis Dixon, Edwin R. Mmbree, Mark Ethridge, Clark Foreman, William C. Haygood, Charles H. Houston, Charles S. Johnson, Julian Mack, Howard W. Odum, Raymond W. Paty, George M. Reynolds, Leonard Rieser, Eleanor Roosevelt, Samuel L. Smith, Harold H. Swift, Robert C. Weaver, Marion (Rosenwald) Ascoli, Adele (Rosenwald) Levy, Julius Rosenwald, Lessing Rosenwald, William Rosenwald, Edgar and Edith (Rosenwald) Stern, Jacob Billikopf, Horace Mann Bond, J. Max Bond, Arna Bontemps, Pearl S。Buck, Horace Cayton, Jonathan Daniels, W. E. B. DuBois, Euell Gallagher, Truman Gibson, H. H. Giles, Laurence Hewes, Langston Hughes, Joseph Lohman, Iillian Smith, Beardsley RumI, George Sanchez, Sara Southall, and Willard Townsend.

In addition to the letters between individuals much of the correspondence is filed under topical or organizational headings. These fall under the large divisions of the Fund, that is, rural education and schoolhouses, teacher training and universities, medical studies and programs, library development, social and research studies, fellowships and scholarships, and race relations projects. The shelf list directs one to these various groups and individuals. Every group engaged in some aspect of Negro American history communicated to some degree with the Rosenwald Fund.

Another level of correspondence may fall into the category of philanthropic organizations. The Fulius Rosenwald Fund cooperated with the officers and programs of the Carnegie Corporation, the General Education Board, the AnsonPhelps Stokes Fund, the Rockefeller Foundation, the Russell Sage Foundation, the Marshall Field Foundation, the Southern Educational Board, and other organizations engaged in giving away money.

## Reports

Included under this category would be the business and financial records of the Fund, annual reports, dockets, minutes, and resolutions of officers,

staff, and trusee meetings. Also included are the reports sent to the Fund by other agencies, organizations, and individuals which either were obligated to submit statements and records or were merely keeping the Fund advised of their activities. From these reports one learns about the daily operation of a philanthropy, its financial situation, its decision-making processes, its personnel problems, and its evaluation of the contemporary social scene.

Manuscripts of speeches, articles, pamphlets, and books
Officers, staff, and research associates prepared speeches, studies, reports, articles, pamphlets, and books for the propagation of the general philosophy of the Fund, i.e., the improvement of human relations. The publication program of the Fund reached a peak during the Depression, when the Fund retreated from a vigorous spending approach to concentrate on less expensive ways to spread a similar influence.

Clippings, photographs, and scrapbooks
Interspersed in the various folders and at the end of the collection are newspaper clippings or scrapbooks related to a specific program or person. On occasion a clipping reveals feelings about the Fund which would not be available through correspondence. Whenever an officer of the Fund traveled and made an address, factual reports and editorial opinions often appeared in the local press. Publicity and press releases sent out by the Fund fall in this category but are filed in separate folders, under "Administration." Other folders contain photographs used by the Fund. Some are of officers or trustees; others record situations in which the Fund was interested. Many photos. of the rural schoolhouses were collected and preserved.

## Fellowships and scholarships

One entire section of the archives holds the material collected in connection with the Fund's fellowship program. The folders containing the applications and correspondence are divided between the persons receiving awards and those denied financial assistance. Rosenwald Fellows include such a large number of prominent individuals it would be impossible to enumerate even a partial selection. The shelf list serves this purpose.

In general, the archives of the Julius Rosenwald Fund provide a look at society in the United States during a most active period (1928-48). So many organizations and people dealt with the Fund that this collection may be useful in numerous ways.
