MAT-109, COLLEGE ALGEBRA, 5 credits

This course is a symbolically intensive, functional approach to algebra that incorporates the use of appropriate technology and application problems. Topics include the study of linear, quadratic, rational, polynomial, exponential and logarithmic functions, the real number axioms, equations, inequalities and systems of equations.

ENG-101, COMP I, 5 credits

An introduction to writing and reading expository prose. Focuses on unity, coherence, emphasis, organization, correctness of grammar and punctuation, editing, and proofreading.

SOC-200, INTRODUCTION TO SOCIOLOGY, 5 credits

The study of human society, the nature of culture, and its organizations. Applications of communication, socialization, mobility, and population growth are analyzed. A comprehensive study of research methods, theories, and principle findings in the field of sociology is discussed.
