CONFIRM YOUR MAJOR



New students may view their major through "Major Maps" after their enrollment confirmation/deposit has been processed by student accounts. To access MajorMaps, <u>Major Maps - Fisk University</u>, and instructions.

Once you register for classes, you may access the change of major form on the Registrar's website and follow the instructions as provided if you wish to change your major in the future. Students who are enrolled in classes will send the change of major form to the Registrar's office for processing.

Once you have been officially accepted to the university and paid your enrollment deposit, you will want to make sure you are taking care of all the key financial processes. Click here see the Financial Aid Checklist:

- File the 23/24 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at www.fafsa.gov
- Log in to the Bulldog "Self-Service" portal and review your award letter in the Financial Aid portal
- Accept/Decline your aid for Fall 23 and Spring 24 within the Financial Aid portal
- If you Accept your student loan(s), complete two required tasks:
- o (1) Entrance Loan Counseling and (2) Master Promissory Note (MPN) at www.studentaid.gov
 - If your FAFSA has been selected for Verification, please go to the link provided to you in the email sent to you from Inceptia.
 - If you are a Tennessee state resident and you would like to be considered for Tennessee State Scholarship fund(s) eligibility you will need to ensure that Fisk University's school code is listed first on your FAFSA along with setting up a student portal account on the TSAC website. https://www.tn.gov/collegepays/tsac-student-portal.html
 - If you have been awarded outside scholarships, please email a copy of the Scholarship letter(s) in pdf form to Ms. Shawn Caulder @ SCaulder@fisk.edu and Ms. Kim Driggers @ kdriggers@fisk.edu
 - If the student needs additional assistance the parent can apply for a parent PLUS loan at www.studentaid.gov and/or the student can apply for a private loan at www.elmselect.com

Being FISK-ally Responsible with Your Education

The Office of Student Accounts welcomes you to the Fisk Family and is excited to help you along your educational journey by providing fiscal guidance, accurate information, and great customer service. In starting this journey, we would need a few of the items below prior to move-in day. You will receive the items listed below in an email from studentaccounts@fisk.edu.

• The Financial Responsibility Form: The Financial Responsibility Form explains the student's responsibility in relation to their ledger balance. This form must be signed by the student acknowledging that they understand they are responsible for any balance due to Fisk University. The form should be reviewed, signed, and returned to the Office of Student Accounts at studentaccounts@fisk.edu by 07/15/2023.



- Fisk University Schedule of Fees 2023-24: This is an itemized schedule of fees for the 2023-24 Academic Year. This schedule can also be found on the Fisk University Website at https://www.fisk.edu/wp-content/uploads/2023/04/Schedule-of-Fees-2023-24.pdf.
- Fisk University Cost Estimator: The Cost Estimator allows you to get an estimation of fees for the semester by choosing the factors below:
 - Status (New Student/Returning Student)
 - Degree Path –(Undergraduate/Graduate)
 - Term (Fall 23/Spring 24)
 - Occupancy (Single/Double/Commuter)

By choosing those individual inputs the estimator will provide an estimated cost. You will also be able to hard key your provided financial aid package and other outside sources of aid to get an estimated remaining balance.

• Pay Fisk Fees: Bills are due by July 31, 2023. This can be accomplished via Direct Payments to Fisk University to cover outstanding balances or via Payment Plans. Information related to Payment Plans will be shared later. This is due to migration to a new system that will better serve our student population.
