## FISK EXECUTIVE LEADERSHIP PROGRAM (FELP) \$15,000

FELP is a training and development program that targets freshmen, sophomores, and juniors. The program takes place each semester, for eight weeks each semester. The program prepares students for internships and discipline focused programs. Students are encouraged to intern during the semester to offset educational costs and college expenses.
