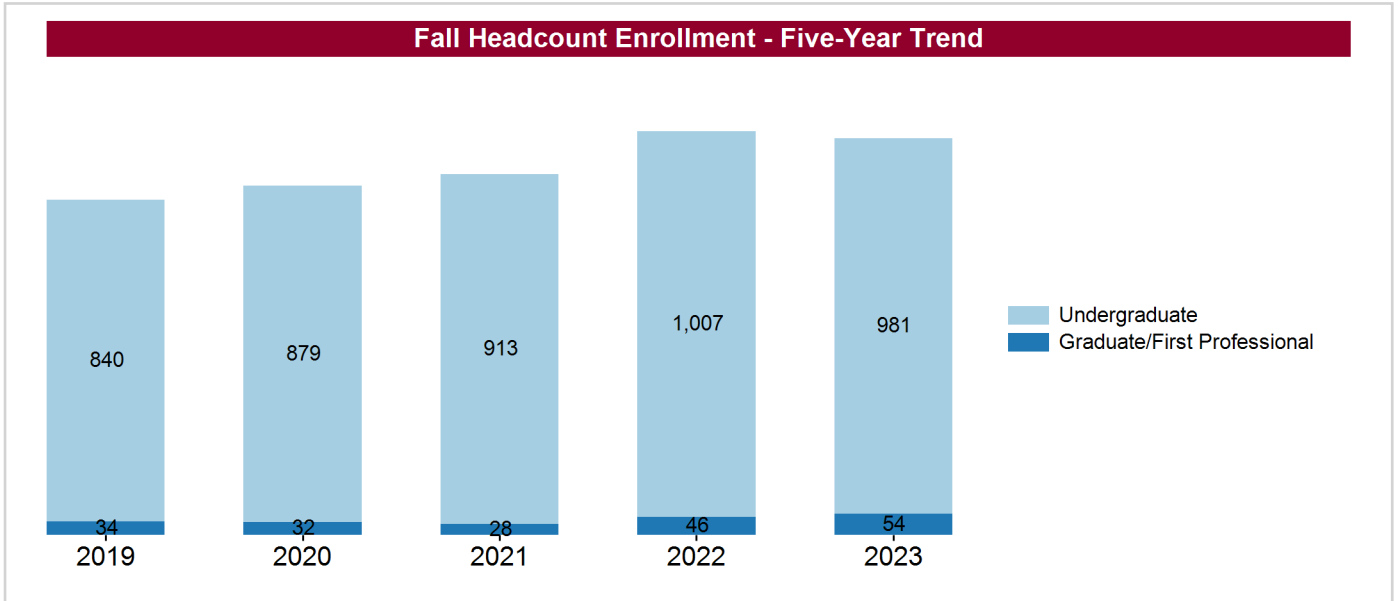

### Headcount by Level

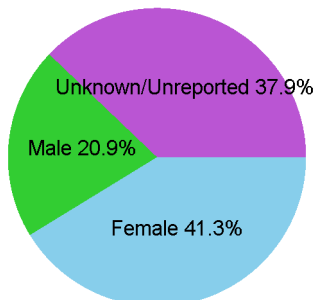

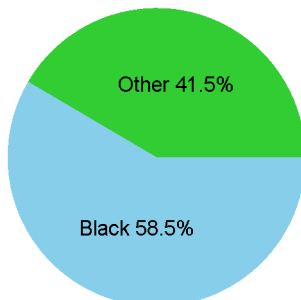

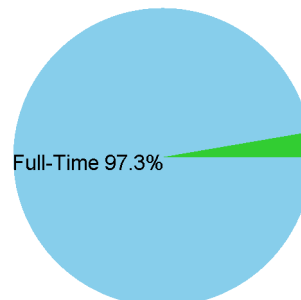
By Gender



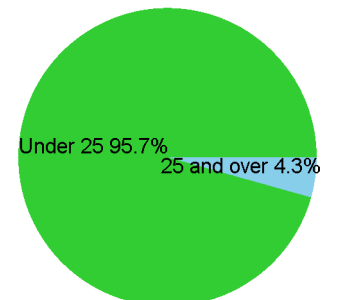
By Race



By Attendance Status

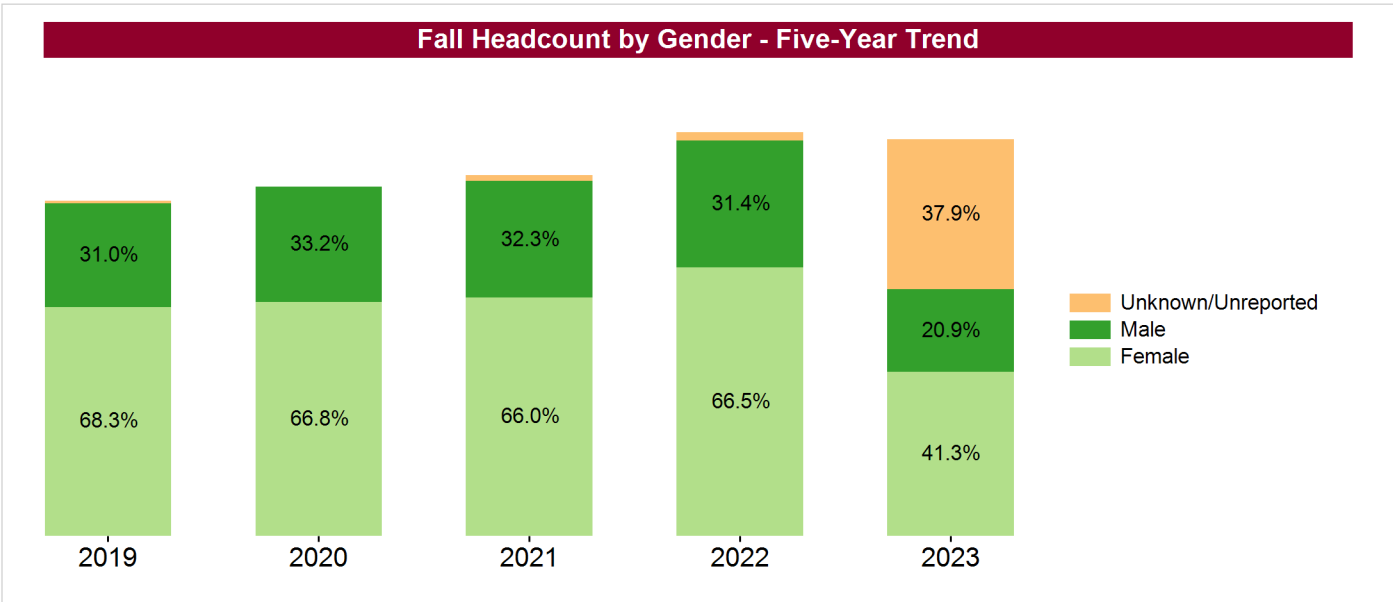

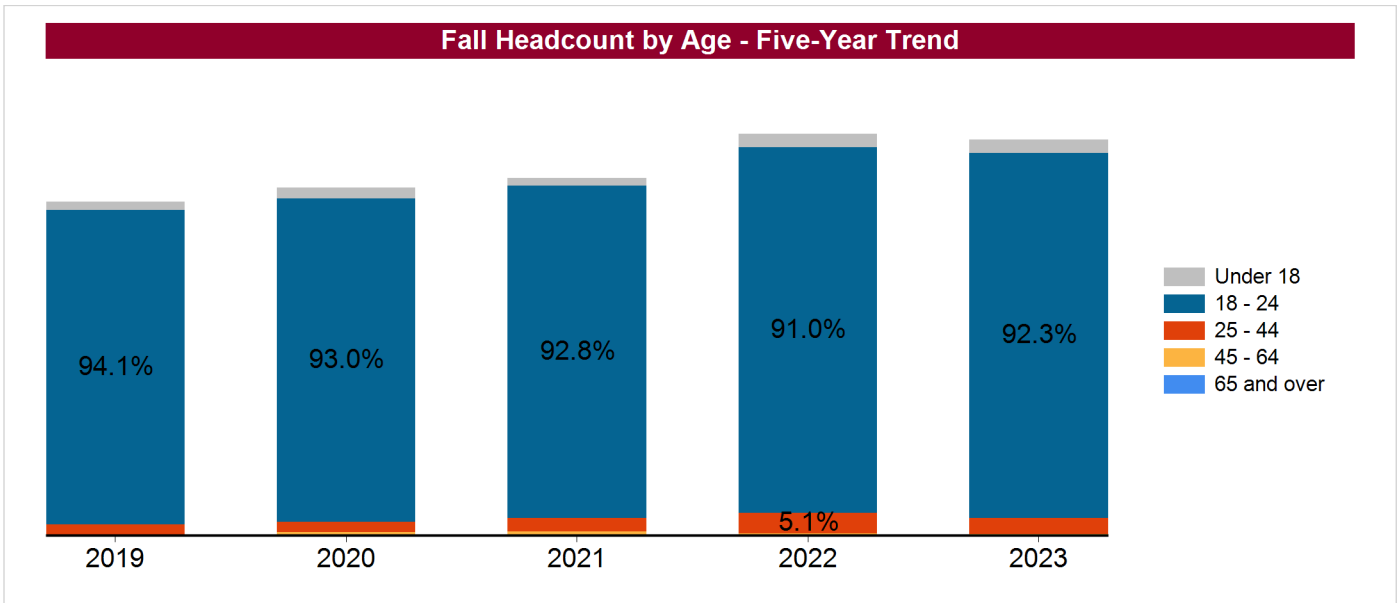

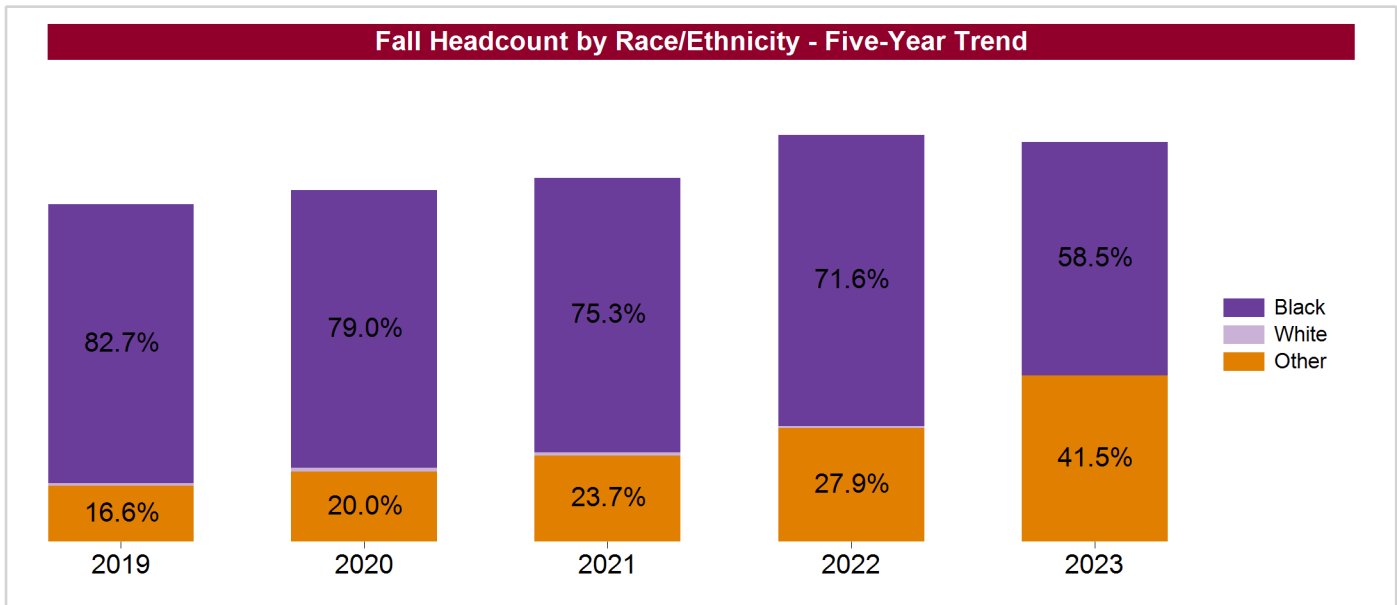

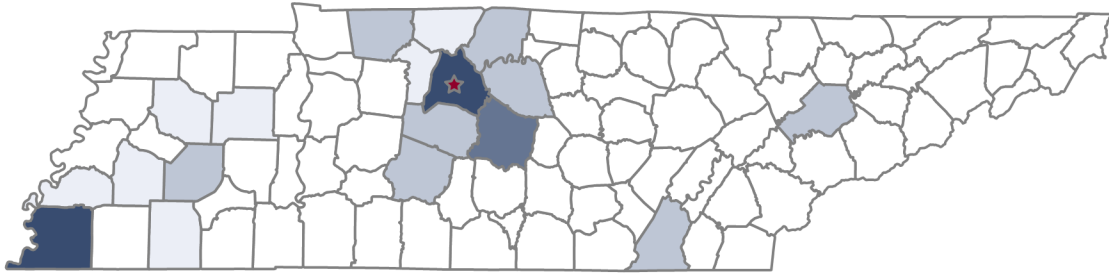

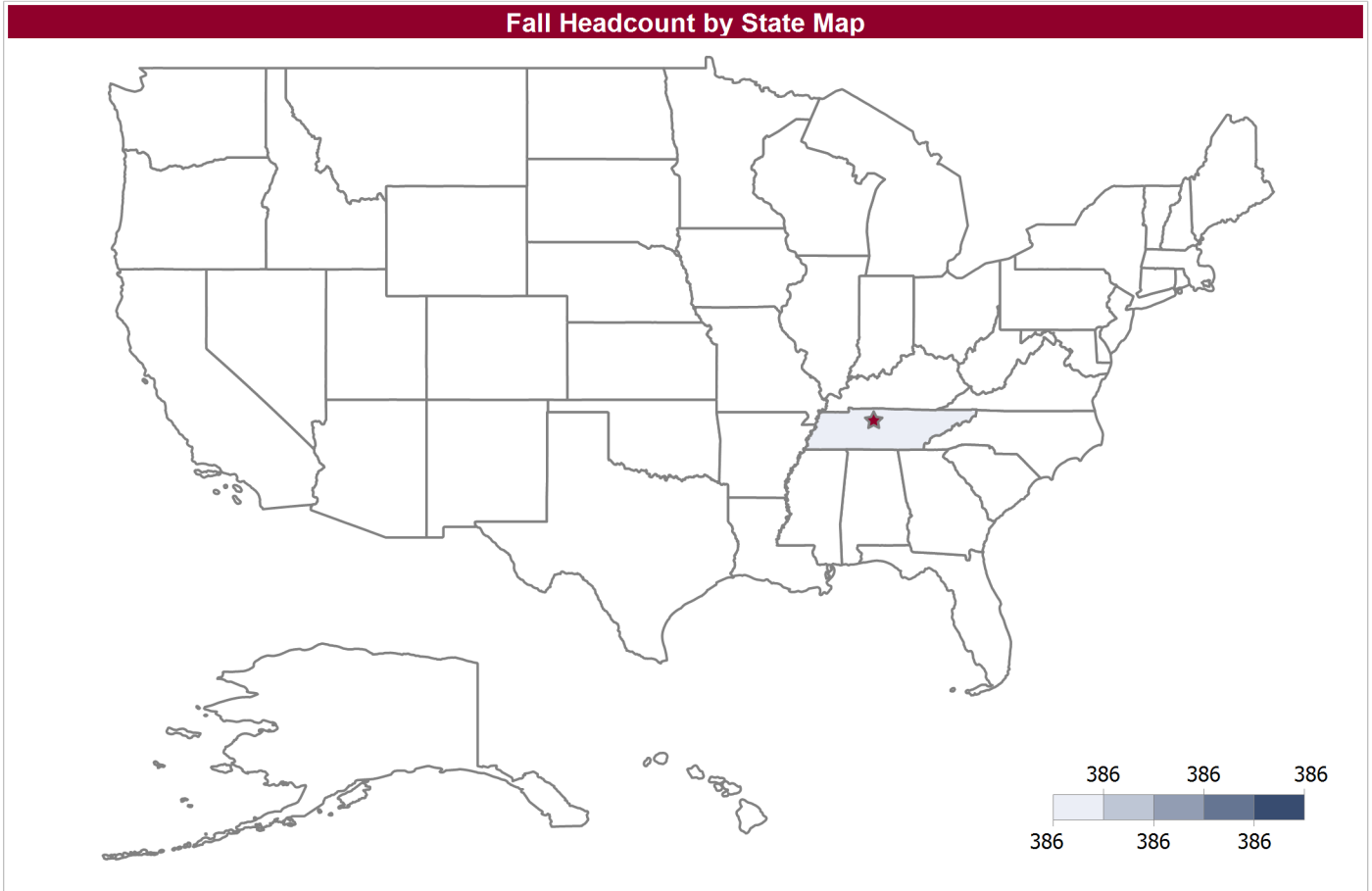
**Fall Headcount by County Map**
